was on framing, mounting and hanging.

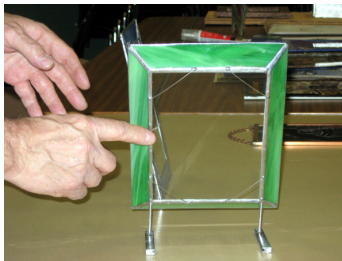


We discussed the proper fitting of wood frames (left).

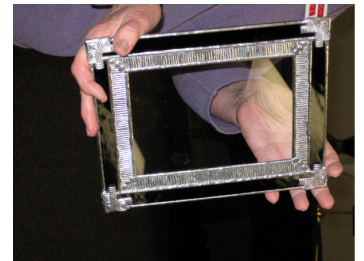
Wanda Hays brought a panel (right) that incorporated a glass frame in its construction.



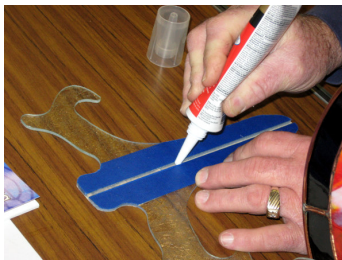
Paul Wosika points out the correct placement of brass tubing used in a photo frame (left).



Carolyn Wallace discussed the use of decorative brass findings. She brought a frame that incorporated them and also used a foil overlay over textured glass (right).



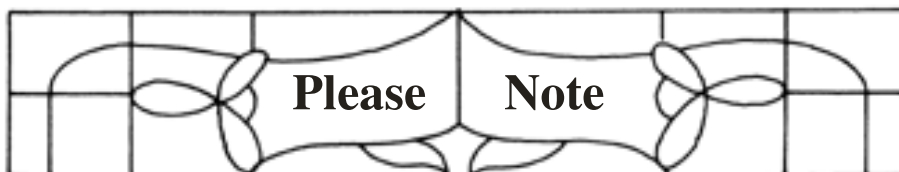

Jim also demonstrated the use of a came bender and he brought a panel with a saddle frame. A saddle frame uses chain inside H came that goes down one side of a panel across the bottom and up the other side.
