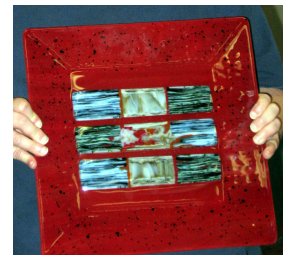

Our **July** meeting will feature a showing of the Joe Porcelli DVD "The Secrets of Fine Patina." Running time for the DVD is approximately 50 minutes. A great patina is the result of knowledge and skill. This program will explain preparation and application techniques necessary to improve metal finishes. It will also provide instruction as to how to protect patina after it has been applied.

Our **August** meeting will feature artist Eric Baker. His work combines steel with glass to create unique sculptures. Those of you who are familiar with Philbrook will recognize Eric Baker as the artist who created "Golden Bliss," a metal and glass sculpture of an autumn tree. Make your plans now to attend.
