We will have a Dirty Santa Gift Exchange. If you wish to participate, please bring a gift to be included. We ask that you limit your expenditure to \$15 or less.

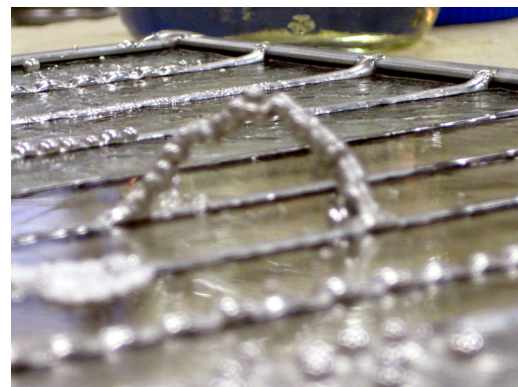
Please join in the festivities as we celebrate the holiday season. We look forward to seeing you there.

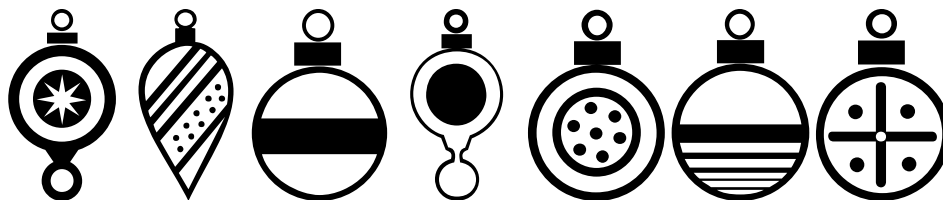
